Principal's Report - 13/2/13

- Pleased to report that classes were formed on the first day with the following structures:
 - K / 1 Wyalla 19
 - → 2 Birrahlee ~ 21
 - → 3/4 Drualla 23
 - √ 4/5 The Swamp 25
 - 6 Terragong 23

School enrolment currently 111.

- Class programs and routines are well under way and it has been a very steady start to the year.
- Class resources P & C money donated at the end of 2012 has been used to buy Core Readers for the classroom. They are being stamped and covered to be used in the classrooms as soon as possible. We have also spent a large amount of money on Reading Comprehension and Spelling and the school is implementing enVisionMATHS from K-6. This will provide scope and sequence as well as continuity between grades. Voluntary contributions from families will be important to maintain paper and ink supplies to support the program The school does not use textbooks as we feel this is limiting but we do photocopy from a wide range of sources. Mathletics will continue to be used in 2013 but there were mixed responses to this from ASR surveys and it may be further investigated during the year.
- Active After School Care began this week and has proven to be very popular with students with approximately 40 students wishing to take part in each session. The program is is still being developed and finalised and modifications may need to be made next term.
- Ms Beesley will not be returning to Jamberoo as she has retired. I am awaiting
 notification from staffing about the unfilled vacancy. I will be endeavouring to keep Mrs
 McCormack for 2013 as she has a sound knowledge of the children and school policies.
- Staff continually review and update policies. We have already revised the Student
 Welfare Policy and will be developing / reviewing our Anti-Bullying Policy and
 Homework Policies this term. We will also be reviewing the Policy and Procedures
 involved with School and House Captain elections. When these policies have been
 reviewed by staff, the recommendations will be taken to the P & C. This issue will be
 further discussed in General Business.
