# Jamberoo P&C Uniform Shop 14 May 14

### Sports Uniforms

We have been advised that all/some teachers are in favour of removing the sports skirt from our school sports uniform. We are not sure of the reasons behind this request so are unable to give information to support or oppose this request. Instead here is some history on the school sports skirts:

- The sports skirt has been part of the sports uniform for at least several years. It gives girls an alternative to the sports shorts. The sports skirt is shown on Uniform Shop photos/price lists/orders as a part of the school sports uniform.
- With the main school uniform, girls have a different uniform to boys. Only the items with a Jamberoo Public School identity are unisex. Girls have different colour & style shorts & pants, as well as both a summer dress and winter tunic.
- The Uniform Shop does sell scungies/sports briefs to wear underneath the sports skirt or dresses and we advise students who buy these items to do this.
- Since Gail began working as a volunteer in the Uniform Shop in 2009, we have not sold many sports skirts - as the "new" (at the time) microfibre sports shorts were introduced circa 2009 and girls were favouring those. It has only been this year that we have seen a resurgence of the sports skirt's popularity.
- We have not purchased any sports skirts since 2009 and as such we do not know the cost price paid for current stock. To buy a netball skirt at today's cost price would be \$14 each. We reduced the price from \$30 to \$15 in 2012 and then to \$10 in 2013 in an attempt to reduce stock numbers.
- To-date we have had a mandate not to purchase more sports skirts because they simply were not selling until this year.
- We currently have around 30 sports skirts in stock with a current retail prices of \$10 which = \$300 worth of stock at retail price.

The process for changing the school uniform is to invite the school community to have its say. Would the P&C like to proceed with Uniform Shop inviting feedback on the removal of the sports skirt via the newsletter and Facebook?
