

Principal's Report - Term 3 - Week 3 2014

- Staff wish to thank the P & C for their donation of money that enabled the school to purchase 25 Ipads. The Ipads have arrived and staff have begun Professional Learning to maximise their use in classrooms. We have also ordered 25 heavy-duty cases to protect the Ipads. Students will not be using them until these cases arrive. 8 Ipads will be stored in Tangalla, Drualla and Birralee - they will be locked away each night. One Ipad will remain in the Library and the other 24 Ipads may be used during Library time if required.
- Kindergarten enrolments are looking very good for 2015 with 17 students having expressed an interest to enrol. Enrolments across the school may be affected from the beginning of 2015 with the new building zone.
