#### • 2014 Kinder Orientation

Uniform Shop are currently preparing for 2014 Kinder Orientation on 30 October and 6 November. As usual Ruth & Gail will talk to 2014 Kinder parents about our school uniforms, provide them with a handout of information on our school uniforms, and have uniforms available at the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Orientation for new Kinder students to try on. Orders will close at the final orientation on 6 November, and this gives us plenty of time to ensure all new Kinder students have their uniforms by the end of term/school year.

#### Year 2 sports uniforms
