• 2014 Kinder Orientation

Uniform Shop presented information on our school uniforms at Kinder Orientation in October and provided uniforms for new students to try on. \$1330 worth of orders was taken. All orders have been filled and are ready to be collected tomorrow (5 Dec).

We think we may have one enrolled 2014 Kinder student who was unable to order their Uniform at Orientation. Not sure how to proceed with this...

• Year 2 sports uniforms

Year 2 students were provided with an order form for sports uniforms and \$210 worth of orders was taken in November. All orders have been filled and will be given to Year 2 students in week 10.

As anticipated, we had enough sports shirts to cover our "large" Year 2 class although we are close to running out of some sizes of sports shirts (minimum order 50 which will = approx \$1600). We are saving hard for this.

Recyclable pouches

Between the office and Uniform Shop, we only have about 8 of the small recyclable money pouches left. Still have quite a number of the larger document ones left.

- These appear to have proved really useful, so what happens next? Should P&C buy more and give them to office and Uniform Shop to sell, or would you like Uniform Shop to take over the management of buying and selling?
- 2. Uniform Shop still owes P&C the money for the ones we have sold. To-date \$90.

• Open day before school starts for students

Uniform Shop will likely be open the day before school starts for students from 2pm-3pm (Gail and Ruth's work schedules permitting). This will allow us to fit out any new students with their uniforms.

• Prices for 2014

Due to price increases by suppliers, we propose having to put a few prices up as per the following list. By a very narrow margin, we have managed to keep prices the same on hats and polo shirts, but these will have to be increased next year at the latest.

Changing suppliers has helped us retain the current price for polo shirts. We have investigated changing hat suppliers, but unfortunately, can't manage to source hats that are as good/wearable as our current ones.

Summer dresses & winter tunics have had to increase. We regret these are getting quite expensive, but Uniform Shop managed to absorb an increased cost price for these throughout this year and are unable to sustain this (cost price is greater than retail price).

We have not ordered sports shirts for around 18 months, but know the price they will cost us. These are custom-made and the only way we could reduce the cost is by changing our sports shirt. Thoughts?
