Uniform Shop Volunteer found & change of opening day

- We have another volunteer!! Reannon Aquilina has kindly volunteered to help in Uniform Shop! To accommodate Reannon's work commitments, we will be changing Uniform Shop to open Tuesday mornings (instead of Mondays) from the start of term 2.

Notice of the change has been publicised in the newsletter Week 1 and on the P&C Facebook page. As always, we are generally happy to help parents purchase uniforms outside of set opening hours, although Gail remains the main contact for this due to Reannon's work commitments.

- As Reannon does work, I may still require some additional assistance during Kinder Orientations etc (depending what day of the week they fall on).

- Additionally, since I drop Matt at school for debating at 8am Tuesday, I can now stay and open Uniform Shop earlier. I discovered last week, there is little point in me going home after dropping Matt off! So, I will likely open Uniform Shop from 8.30am going forward.

Uniform Shop "front" door

- Last term, Kate advised us the Uniform Shop outside "front" door was to be kept locked at all times – as it was not getting locked of an evening and school security was compromised. Due to this being a school master key, Uniform Shop volunteers are not permitted a copy. Each time we want to access Uniform Shop we need to obtain the master key from Kate or another member of staff. We often access Uniform Shop multiple times per day for parents who can't make our regular open times, or to deliver uniforms picked up from suppliers/post office, perform stocktake, bag orders, etc. This is not unworkable, but is certainly time-consuming and can be frustrating if Kate is not around, as we would prefer not to bother teachers to borrow keys.

On Tues 3 May 2016, Mrs Xuerub advised that the Uniform Shop "front door" should be left open, so teachers are able to access the staff toilet and art storeroom, which are also located next to the Uniform Shop. Since then, however, the door appears to have been left locked.

- Not sure how this will resolve over the next couple of weeks, but our preference would be to have Uniform Shop easily accessible. That way, we can go about running the Uniform Shop without having to interrupt school staff.

Winter Orders

We encourage all parents to order uniforms for winter during term 1 via the form in the newsletter as it enables us to better manage our stock levels. This year, we had a healthy number of winter orders with quite a few parents taking advantage of our once-per year offer to order long-sleeve polo shirts and full-zip polar fleeces not kept in stock.

Winter Orders have now been distributed. We also have plenty of winter uniform items in stock for over-the-counter sales.
