
CHANGE OF DATE & VENUE FOR NEXT P & C MEETING

What is the source of music? Where do we make our first connection with the sounds of life, with rhythm? Teranga uses the energy and musical heritage of Africa to take students on a journey guided and inspired by their own inner music; the heartbeat. The ensemble introduces every student to their own inner music, then transport them to Africa where they learn to use it, through dance, percussion and other instruments. Students learn to listen to their own intuitions, connect with nature and communicate, create and share with others.

This performance is part of your school's learning program and builds on preparatory work done in the classroom utilising the Teranga resource kit. The kit's teaching resources are linked directly to the music curriculum as well as other curriculum areas especially around literacy and numeracy.
