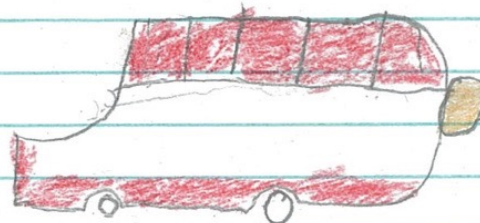
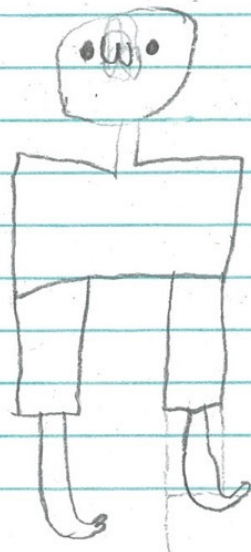
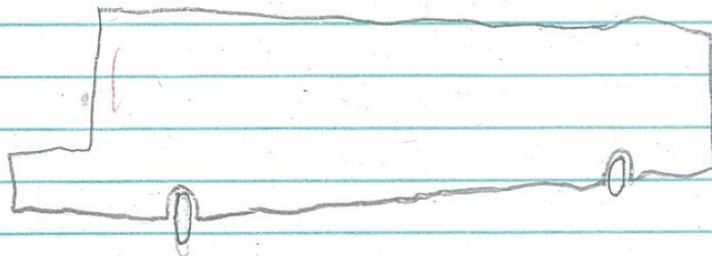


Letter From Patrick
