#### **Church Parking**

Recently there have been discussions involving the P & C and staff at Jamberoo Public School about issues relating to student and community safety in and around Jamberoo Anglican Church parking lot adjacent to the school. Many people have raised concerns about the heavy traffic going in and out of the church car park and the risk of harm to our students and the community members who use the area. Another concern is that with larger student enrolments in 2017 there will be an increase in the number of cars using the church parking area next year which will again further the risk to our students.

To divert traffic away from the school it has been decided that in the last week of term (Monday 12<sup>th</sup> December-

**Friday 16<sup>th</sup> December)** we will <u>trial</u> having the church car park closed during the peak afternoon pick up period. Parents/families will still be able to pick up their child using available street parking. We encourage families to use the parking area located at Kevin Walsh Oval (near the skate park). The positives from this are that there will be less traffic in and around the school and it will promote a healthy lifestyle, providing the opportunity for students and parents to walk from school.

To alleviate stress for parents who have concerns about their child walking down Churchill Street to the parking lot at Kevin Walsh Oval a staff member from Jamberoo Public School will walk the children down to the parking area. Every afternoon a staff member (usually myself) meets the students who catch the bus at the school gate (near the library) and walks the students across the road to their designated bus. During next week's trial, families who wish for their child to be walked to Kevin Walsh Oval are to have their child meet the supervising teacher at the front gate straight after school, 3:00pm.

The staff member on duty will then walk the bus students and the students who are being picked up from the car park at Kevin Walsh Oval across the crossing and down the eastern side of Churchill St. Your child will be supervised for the entire journey to Kevin Walsh Oval. For parents of bus students nothing will change, there will just be a larger group of students to walk across the road.

Please remember that this is a trial for next week only at this stage. I look forward to receiving your feedback at the completion of the trial. At the forefront of the school's decision making is that student welfare and safety is always our highest priority. The trial will only affect the families who are currently using the church car park for <u>afternoon pick-ups. Families</u> who have their child ride, walk, catch the bus to school or are picked up in a different location will not be affected. Your cooperation in this matter is greatly appreciated. Please do not hesitate to contact me if you have any questions.
