| Matters Arising | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Toilet Upgrade: We have obtained quotes for push style taps, stainless-steel soap dispensers and stainless-steel paper towel holders for both the girls and boys toilet. The cheapest quote came in from Mitre 10 utilising Luke Rogers’ trade discount. The total for 6 x taps, 4 x soap dispensers and 2 x paper towel holders is \$1291.91. Motion to pay this amount passed. Doors for the girls (3) and boys (2) toilets were quoted at both Bunnings and Mitre 10. Bunnings came in cheaper at \$720.00 Motion to pay this amount passed. A preliminary mirror quote was obtained from Clymax Glass. This quote was estimated at \$340.00 for 2 x framed mirrors installed. Final measurements/quotes will need to be obtained by both Clymax Glass and Gads Glass once tiling in the area is completed. Motion to pay \$340.00 passed.
